

UNIFORM AND APPEARANCE ADVICE

- Shoes should be a traditional style and free of logos. Boots, mules, sandals and trainer/canvas-styles are NOT acceptable. Examples of acceptable and unacceptable styles are available to view, for guidance, in school and on our website.
- In order to be appropriate for school, skirt hems should be no more than 7.5cm (3") above the knee.
- We suggest that tights be a minimum of 60 denier. Leggings, leg warmers or longer-style socks are not permitted.
- A pullover/sweatshirt must be worn at all times (except if a summer polo shirt is worn, these can be worn in the summer term only). It is left to the discretion of individual teachers to allow students to take it off in lessons.
- In summer, when wearing the school polo shirt no belt should be worn over it or additional t-shirt underneath. It is not to be worn for PE.
- Uniform/PE kit is only available from Henry Smith in Shipley, Rawcliffes in Bradford and Natasha Schoolwear in Bradford.
- Please ensure all uniform is clearly and permanently labelled.

- The wearing of makeup is discouraged. If makeup is worn it should be subtle enough for school. Unnatural false eyelashes and acrylic nails are not permitted.
- To avoid health and safety hazards no jewellery is allowed, except two pairs of stud/sleeper earrings in the earlobe. We discourage ear plugs but they may be worn if they are no larger than point 12 and flesh coloured. Facial piercings, tongue studs or retainers and tragus piercings are not permitted. Staff will confiscate any additional items of jewellery.

- Hair colours must be natural looking. Extreme hair styles are not acceptable

Colours that are clearly not natural including but not limited to pink, red, blue, purple.

Hair that is tipped or sectioned using different natural and/or unnatural colours including but not limited to strand(s) of blonde with black or black with auburn; strands of red with black hair.

Shaved patterns cut into hair including but not limited to names, patterns, tramlines.

Non-conventional ponytails including but not limited to extended strands at the nape of the neck.
